Both storage areas must be easily accessible from Uranium City

2. Submissions:

2.1 Bidders are requested to provide the following information to enable comprehensive and accurate evaluation as part of their submission:

- Description of storage facilities/area
- Location and accessibility
- Security measures in place (fences, locks, barred windows, etc.)
- Availability (required by March 2009)
- Lease requirements (timeframe, conditions, etc.)

- 2.2 Bidders are requested to provide warranty details along with specifications and terms.
- 2.3 Bidders are requested to confirm their ability to meet the delivery schedule and verify the delivery terms outlined in the attached Specifications.
- 2.4 SRC reserves the right to reject or accept any quotation or part thereof and may cancel this RFQ at any time.
- 2.5 Quotations may be evaluated at SRC's sole discretion on any or all of the information submitted including clarifications, additional information, modifications and negotiated changes.
- 2.6 This RFQ should not be construed as an agreement to purchase goods or services. SRC is not bound to enter into a contract with the vendor that submits the lowest priced quotation or with any vendor.
- 2.7 Prices quoted shall be exclusive of all taxes. If applicable, Provincial Sales Tax (PST) shall be quoted separately from the price. SRC is GST exempt; SRC's registration number is 107864258.
